**Parking:** The park collects a mandatory fee: \$4 per car or \$10 for vehicles seating 10 or more.

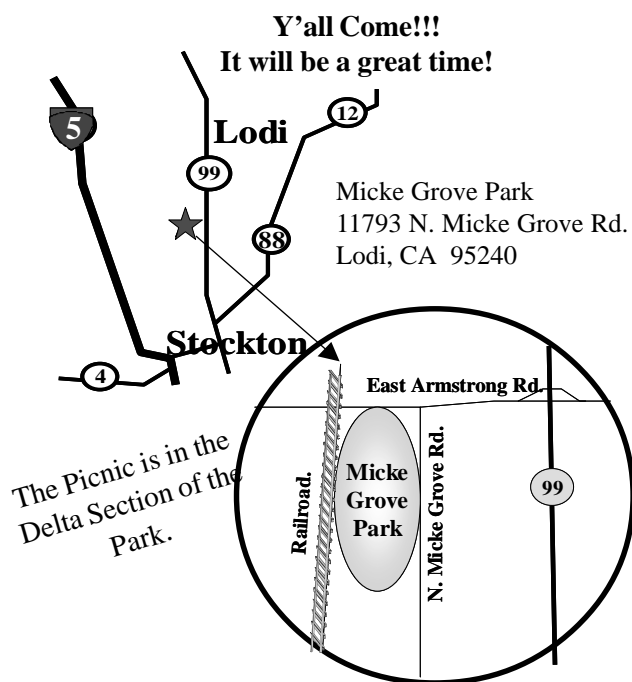
**Child Care:** Possible (we're still working this), but please don't count on it.

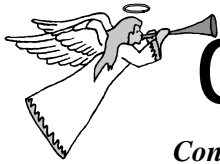

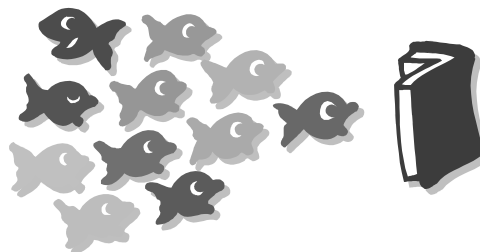

### Walk Application Process

Applications for the next set of Walks (Men's and Women's) should be mailed to the registrar no sooner than the Monday following the current Women's Walk (see the Calendar for dates). Pilgrim fees of \$75.00 must be sent with the application.

Once received, applications will be placed in postmark order – as opposed to date received. Postcards are then sent to the pilgrims and their sponsors confirming the pilgrim for the Walk. If there are more applications received than there are spaces available on a Walk, then those applicants are placed on a waiting list and postcards are mailed to the applicants and their sponsors informing them of the waiting list process.

Generally, the waiting list is closed just prior to the Men's Walk and applications are returned to the sponsors. This is done so that sponsors can re-submit applications in a timely manner if the pilgrim chooses to re-apply. The registrar will initiate a refund of pilgrim fees for those applicants who will not be able to attend the current Walk.

Applications from the waiting list are not held over from one Walk to the next, so we begin each Walk with a clean slate.
