**Space Divider Donations Needed**

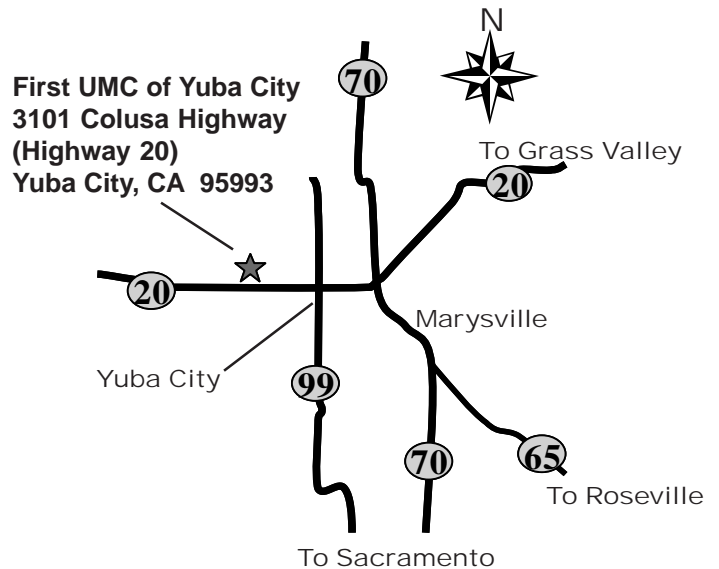

### Snacks, Goodies and Agape

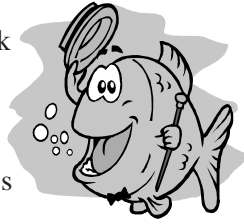

It comes in .pdf format, which means you need the free popular download, Acrobat Reader (available at <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep2.html>), to view and print it. 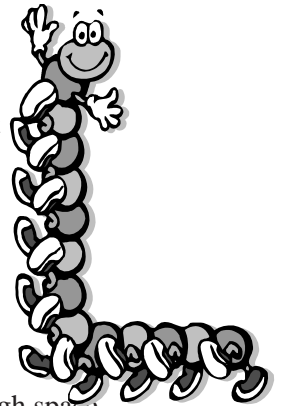

What is Chrysalis? 'Chrysalis' is the name for the youth and young adult version of The Walk to Emmaus, as it symbolizes the spiritual growth essential between adolescence and adulthood. To become a butterfly, a caterpillar goes through a growth stage called 'chrysalis.' On the surface it may not look like much is happening, but the process results in a magnificent butterfly, soaring through space, dazzling all. The chrysalis process symbolizes how Christ transforms people into something beyond their dreams



What happens on a Chrysalis Flight? Candidates spend three exciting days with others their age in worship, prayer, fellowship, creative expression, recreation, singing, and discussion. They experience the love of God through prayers and acts of service from a loving, supportive community (Emmaus folks, that's you).
