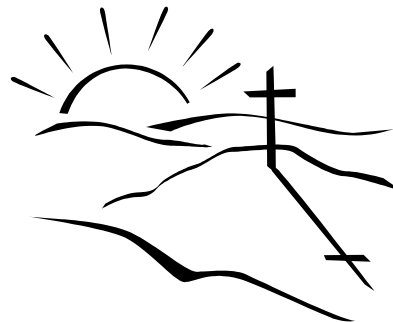

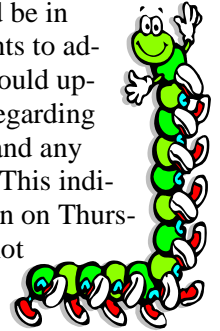

## From the Chrysalis Community Lay Director

Ecclesiastes says that there is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven. Right now the Chrysalis Board is in a season of change as it asks Community members to pray about serving on the Board in the following positions.

**Board Secretary** - This individual is required to attend the four Board meetings that are held during the year, typically in the months of January, April, July, and October. The meetings are usually held in the Sacramento area, although we are trying to have one meeting a year in Reno to accommodate Nevada folks. Meetings are held on a Saturday from 9:30 until 3:30. The Secretary takes the minutes for each meeting, sending them out to the Board members via email at a later date.

**Board Registrar** - This individual is responsible for receiving and processing all applications for each Flight, both Team and Caterpillar. Their name and address would appear on all applications as the contact person prior to a Flight. The Registrar would be in direct contact with sponsors and parents to advise of pre-Flight preparations, and would update the Lay Director of each Flight regarding the number of applications received, and any medical conditions or food allergies. This individual could also help with registration on Thursday evening of the Flight, but this is not a requirement.



In addition, we are looking for someone to assist the Community Agape Coordinator in the following position:

**Manual Coordinator** - This individual would report to the Community Agape Coordinator. He or she would be responsible for maintaining the Flight manuals in good condition, checking after each Flight that all have been received and make any repairs necessary.

To be a member of the Chrysalis Board, you will need a heart for the Emmaus/Chrysalis experience, and a desire to see youth connect with God on a very personal level. ## From the Emmaus Community Spiritual Director

Just as clergy serve on the 72 hour Walk to Emmaus weekend, some also serve on the Board of Directors. The clergy role on the Board is to provide spiritual counsel, serve communion, and to schedule clergy to serve on upcoming Walk weekends. All clergy who work on Walk weekends and who serve as Board members have previously participated as Pilgrims on a Walk to Emmaus, or similar 72-hour experience.

Currently there are three clergy serving on the Northern California Nevada Walk to Emmaus Board: Kathryn Dunning, Gary McAnnally and Dawn Pidlypchak. All three happen to be United Methodist and are currently serving as pastors of local churches. Kathryn is the Community Spiritual Director and the pastor at Kings Beach (Lake Tahoe) UMC. Gary serves as pastor at Lincoln UMC, and Dawn is the pastor of Portola UMC. Similar to lay persons who serve on the Board, clergy are generally elected to serve a three year term.
