### Community Trailer Stolen

Ten days before the July 27<sup>th</sup> Men's Walk at Carson Valley UMC in Gardnerville, Nevada, the Community trailer was stolen from the parking lot at another church. No one has seen the trailer or its contents since. Fortunately, very little Chrysalis materiel was in the trailer when it disappeared.

Immediately upon learning the trailer was gone, a recovery plan was developed and implemented. Included was a broadcast e-mail to the Community telling of what had happened and what was needed. The Community responded beautifully. Three Community super chiefs were asked to volunteer – one each for Kitchen, Decorations, and Agape – then were asked to figure out what was needed and go buy it. Funds flowed in to cover the acquisitions.

The result? Two great Walks at Carson Valley UMC that ran as smoothly as Walks ever do. Praise God and bless all the folks through whom He provided!

Besides funds, we are being blessed with special items such as new banners and a new large cross, all lovingly hand crafted. A major donation by a non-Community member has covered the cost of the new trailer. That trailer is being outfitted with shelving and will be available soon.

In retrospect, perhaps God took our old trailer away from us because it had become unsafe. All in all, we will end up better off than when this all began. And

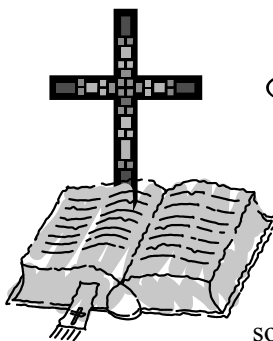


Please note that childcare is not provided at Walks or Flights by the Community or churches. We are not always able to guarantee proper personnel and facilities therefore

It is appropriate to close with one of a number of silver lining stories. With the loss of the old trailer, we had very little table and bed agape. The broadcast e-mail to the Community telling about the trailer mishap also asked for agape donations and we ended up with abundance. Some of this will go to support Walks in Ghana. We also received an e-mail from someone working a girl's Epiphany event in Texas asking for an agape letter. For Epiphany, think of a Chrysalis Flight in a Kairos inside setting – in this case, young women under eighteen being held in a correctional facility. Besides our Community letter, we are sending as much appropriate agape as we can from our abundance. Praise God and praise His work through our Community! De Colores! and Fly with Christ!

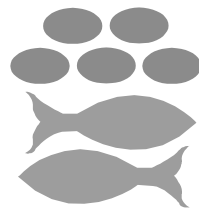

**Pilgrim Application Process**

Applications for the next Men's and Women's Walks for March in Atwater, California, can be postmarked no sooner than November 7th. The cut-off is two weeks prior to each walk. A \$75 Pilgrim fee must accompany the application.

Applications are placed in postmark order with applicants and their sponsors receiving postcards notifying them if the applicant has been accepted or has been placed on the waiting list. If there is not sufficient room for an applicant, the \$75 fee is returned and they are encouraged to apply again - the waiting list is not held over for a subsequent Walk so it is necessary to reapply.
